

- Title 1 is government funded money.
- Discussed School-wide Buildings vs Targeted Assisted Buildings
- Edison is a targeted assisted building based on a percentage of free and reduced lunches. Targeted assisted means that students in need are targeted for assistance vs school-wide where they can work with any kids in the building.
- Results from MAP reading scores are used to come up with targeted list. A list of students is made, ranked by score, and addressed from bottom up. At Edison, Title 1 teachers push in, which means they go into the classroom vs removing the child from the classroom.
- Need parental permission to work with the child.
- Title 1 also helps with One School One Book and this money paid for the One School One Book books.
- Title 1 Night will be coming up towards the end of the year.
